Col Roxanne T. Toy is the Commandant of the Department of the Air Force Officer Training School, Maxwell Air Force Base, AL. Officer Training School commissions and trains approximately 3,700 total force line and non-line officers annually for the Air Force's Active Duty, Reserves, Air National Guard, and Space Force with a \$75 million world-class campus, including three field training sites, and is the largest training campus within Maxwell Air Force Base.

Col Toy began her military career in June 1991 as an enlisted Army soldier. With over 33 years of service, she has served both stateside and overseas, including Korea and Germany. In 1998, Col Toy commissioned as a psychological operations officer and continued her service overseas within the Headquarters Allied Force Command. Col Toy has deployed to multiple locations worldwide including Bosnia, Kosovo, Syria, Iraq, Afghanistan, Kuwait, Qatar, Jordan, Bahrain, United Arab Emirates, Saudi Arabia, Turkey, and the Ukraine, supporting operations and campaigns throughout the world. She transferred to the California Air National Guard in 2001 at the 129th Rescue Wing, Moffett Federal Airfield, California, where she held two squadron commands. From there she transferred to the National Guard Bureau holding both Staff and Joint Staff assignments. Lastly, Col Toy has held two group commands and has served as the Deputy Commandant prior to her transition as Commandant of Officer Training School.
