PALACE FRONT is...

A program allowing Airmen who already have an approved DOS to seamlessly transfer from active service to selected reserve service within the ARC.





PALACE FRONT is not...

The PALACE FRONT program is not a voluntary separation program or a Pre-ETS process that will waive a current enlistment contract or active duty service commitment.

For Active Duty members who have completed half their service commitment (2/3rds for officers)

PALACE CHASE is...

A voluntary, early release program allowing active duty Airmen who have already completed half their initial service commitment (2/3 for officers) to transfer from active service to the Air Reserve Component by extending their service obligation.





PALACE CHASE is not...

The PALACE CHASE program is not an early separation program that will reduce a member's current service obligation by transferring to the Reserve.

Serve Full or Part-Time
