Maj. Christopher B. Smith is the Director of Operations for the Air Force's Warrant Officer Training School under the Jeanne M. Holm Center for Accessions and Citizen Development at Maxwell Air Force Base, Montgomery, Alabama. In this role, Maj Smith is directly responsible for the operations and execution for the Air Force's first-ever Warrant Officer accessions training program. As the director, he ensures successful training and development in producing Warrant Officers ready to meet evolving global challenges in support of the National Defense Strategy.

Major Smith enlisted in the Air Force in June 2002 and began his military career as a Security Forces Journeyman. During this time, he took part in multiple deployments supporting Operation Iraqi Freedom and Operation Enduring Freedom. He earned his commission in 2012 through AFROTC at The University of Georgia. He completed Security Forces officer training in October 2013 and has since held a variety of positions in force protection and anti-terrorism fields. In 2021 Major Smith received his certification as a Foreign Area Officer. Major Smith has multiple deployments to Africa and the Middle East. Prior to his current position, Major Smith was the Air University International Engagements Branch Chief.
