Maj Tanner A. Allshouse is the Commandant of the Air Force's Warrant Officer Training School under the Jeanne M. Holm Center for Accessions and Citizen Development at Maxwell Air Force Base, Montgomery, Alabama. He is responsible for the comprehensive management of schoolhouse operations, training, and professional development for 150 candidates annually. He directs the development of highly skilled warfighting advisors, prepared to integrate technical and specialized expertise across the spectrum of strategic competition.

The Major commissioned in May 2011 as a Reserve Officer Training Corps graduate from George Mason University. He has served in a variety of positions at the squadron and group levels. Maj Allshouse served as a Squadron Officer School instructor in the 32d Student Squadron where he oversaw teaching and evaluating 84 Department of the Air Force Company Grade Officers, Department of Defense Civilians and International Officers annually on their professional growth and development. Prior to his current position, the Major was the Squadron Officer School's Deputy Director of Future Plans.

Maj Allshouse has deployed to Al Udeid Air Base, Qatar and Bagram Airfield, Afghanistan in support of Operation's RESOLUTE SUPPORT, ENDURING FREEDOM, FREEDOM SENTINEL, and INHERENT RESOLVE, accumulating more than 1,100 combat hours. Furthermore, he has flown in support of Northern and Southern Command taskings against counter-drug operations. Previously, he has flown both the T-6A Texan the T-1 Jayhawk, E-8C Joint Surveillance Target Attack Radar System and the EC-130H Compass Call.
